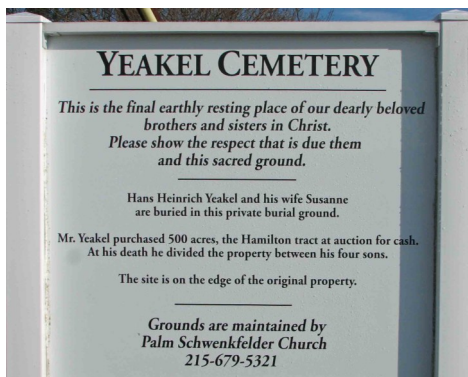


Hans Heinrich Yeakel Cemetery

Station and Treichler Roads, Upper Hanover Township, Montgomery County, PA

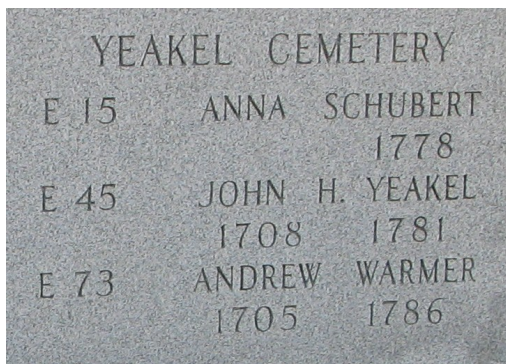
From Route 29 in the center of Palm, drive 0.75 mile northeast on Station Road. A right-of-way permits walking along the fence row to the enclosed stone walled burial ground of Hans Heinrich Yeakel. It lies about 1700 feet from the intersection of Station and Treichler Roads.



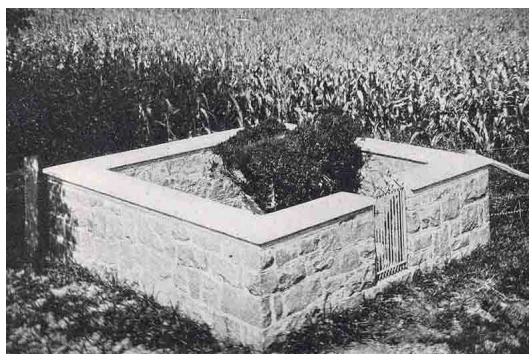

'Andreas Warmer 1786"' [see below]
