Hagerstown, MD

[E 1] George Schultz purchased 100 acres a few miles west of Hagerstown, Frederick County, MD, in 1763 and in 1773 purchased another 33 acres. It is probable that he was buried in a private cemetery on this land some distance from the farm buildings, although no stone marks his grave.

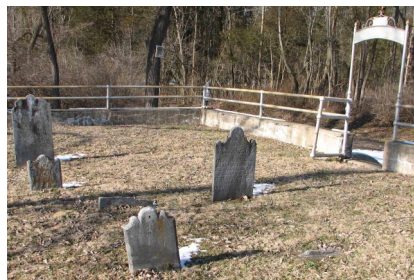

Henry Antes Burial Plot and Adjacent Area

Antes Plantation, 318 Colonial Road, Perkiomenville, Montgomery County, PA

From Route 73 (Big Road/Skipack Pike), turn southwest onto Colonial Road. In about 0.9 miles, turn right onto Hildebeidel Road. The Henry Antes Burial plot is located on the knoll to the left.

According to tradition, quite a number of bodies are buried in the grounds that adjoin the Henry Antes burial lot, near the former homestead of [E 18] George Heebner, "Falckner Schwam," Upper Frederick Township, Montgomery Co., PA. It is probable that the plot was used as a burial place by the Heebners, but not an established fact.

Schultz Family Farm Burial Ground (former)

Melchior Schultz owned land near the Dr. J. G. Mensch Mill, Pennsburg, PA. It is surmised that Melchior Schultz, along with his father and mother, George and Anna, are buried in unmarked graves on an unenclosed plot on this tract. This land is now under water of Green Lane Reservoir off Mensch Dam Road, near Pennsburg, Montgomery County, PA.

St. Paul's Evangelical Lutheran Church Cemetery

1244 St. Paul's Church Road & Frye Road, Upper Hanover Township, Montgomery County, PA

From the intersection of Rt. 29 (Gravel Pike) and Route 663 in Pennsburg, travel south on Gravel Pike/Main Street. Turn left onto 11th Street and go about 0.5 miles to stop sign, then right onto Frye Road. Go 0.1 mile and St Paul's Church will be on the right. The old cemetery is located just behind the church.
